WILDERNESS RIVER ADVENTURES RULES OF THE RIVER

LIFE PRESERVERS:

- Life preservers are numbered. You will keep the same one for the entire trip
- You must wear your life preserver and keep it buckled at all times while you are on the boat. (N.P.S. Regulation)
- > You should snap your life preserver to the boat when hiking during the day.
- Wear the life preserver off the boat at night, and keep it with you. It can also be used as a pillow.

SWIMMING:

- > Swim only when and where your guide says it is safe.
- > Swimming is NOT permitted in the Phantom Ranch area. (N.P.S. Regulation)
- ➤ Absolutely NO DIVING permitted into the river or tributaries during side hikes.

PREPARING FOR A RAPID:

- Put away cameras and secure any objects that may move about.
- > Adjust your life preserver straps tightly.
- > Sit down and hold on to the hand lines. Your guide will instruct you where to sit and what to hold on to.

INVOLUNTARY SWIMMING - (If you fall overboard in a rapid):

- > Try to maintain eye contact with your guides. A line will be thrown to you.
- > If at all possible hang on to the hand line or swim to the boat.
- Keep your legs and feet in front of you and hold onto the collar of your life jacket, if you can't hold on to the hand lines.

HIKING RULES:

- All hikes are optional your guides will inform you of the degree of difficulty of the hikes.
- All hikes are guided. Never hike alone. Observe and practice the "buddy system".
- You are only allowed to hike on established trails. No multiple trailing.
- **➤** Absolutely "NO ROCK CLIMBING".

RESTROOMS:

- > The Wilderness crew maintains all toilet facilities.
- > All solid waste is carried out in containers on the boats.
- **Your guides will explain toilet and sanitation facilities.**

KEEP THE CANYON CLEAN:

- Use an empty can for cigarette butts. Do not throw them in the river or on the beach.
- Do not remove anything from the canyon. It can result in fines by the National Park Service.
- > Leave your camp area cleaner than you found it.

BATHING WITH SOAP (Biodegradable or otherwise):

- **>** Bathing is only permitted in the main river.
- NO bathing in side streams or pools.
- ➤ Solar showers must be used at river edge (N.P.S. Regulation)

AROUND CAMP AND OTHER STOPS:

- Practice common sense, observe all safety rules and use buddy system.
- Act respectful, be timely and courteous to staff, guests, and other trips.
- > Always wear shoes.
- > Wash hands after using toilet facilities and before handling or eating food. Treated water & soap is provided.
- As an extra precaution, drink only water supplied by the Wilderness crew.

COMPLYING WITH THESE RULES WILL HELP YOUR CREW ENSURE YOUR SAFETY
