CANCELLATION POLICY

DEPOSIT

A **\$400 nonrefundable** deposit per person is required at the time of booking.

Name change or transferring to the following year is not allowed.

Transferring to another date in the same year is allowed based on availability up to 90 days prior to trip departure. A service charge of \$50 per person will apply.

Pay Now rate is nonrefundable, nontransferable (full amount is due at the time of booking)

FINAL PAYMENT

Final payment is due 90 days prior to trip departure date.

Once your final payment is paid, the trip cost is non-refundable.

We DO NOT automatically charge your credit card for the balance.

You must contact our office for final payments 928-645-0343 or 928-645-4967.

Wilderness River Adventures reserves the right to cancel any river trip or decrease the size for any prudent reason when deemed necessary. If trips are cancelled by the company, all trip monies are refunded.

TRAVEL CANCELLATION INSURANCE

HELP PROTECT THE GRAND CANYON

When you book with Wilderness River Adventures on your statement you will notice that a Dollar (1.00) per day per person “Pass Through Fee” has been added to your balance. This money is passed on to groups through the Grand Canyon Fund, Inc. and awarded in the form of grants to non-profit groups and those working to provide access to backcountry outdoor experiences for those with physical and socioeconomic challenges. ONE TRIP A YEAR RULE

Due to limited availability, the National Park Service restricts recreational boating opportunities on the Colorado River within Grand Canyon National Park to one trip per year per individual. Because of this regulation, Wilderness River Adventures cannot accept a reservation from any individual who has or will participate in any other full or partial canyon commercial or non-commercial river trips within the same calendar year. Grand Canyon National Park's one-trip-per-year rule is strictly enforced.
