RESERVATIONS

You can make reservations for any Wilderness River Adventures trip online www.riveradventures.com or call our office 928-645-6047 / 928-645-0343. If you call, we can hold your seat for up to a week while you send your completed reservation form and non-refundable deposit of \$400/ person. If we cannot confirm you on one of our trips, we can place your name on our waiting list. We advise you to book early.

INCLUDED IN THE COST OF YOUR TRIP

Waterproof bag for clothing, cot, tent, camp chair, sheet and ground tarp

Sleeping bag

Waterproof ammo can 5.5"X7"X11" (only on motor trips), waterproof day bag 20"X12"

All meals while on the river - fresh meat and produce

Non-alcoholic beverages – Pepsi products diet and regular

A souvenir "Wilderness River Adventure" travel mug

A personal floatation device is issued to all passengers, which must be worn while you are on the boat

On full and upper canyon trips also included

Charter flight from Las Vegas to Page, AZ

Bus transportation from Lake Powell Resort to Lees Ferry

On full and lower canyon trips also included

Helicopter flight at Whitmore Wash to Bar 10 Ranch

Lunch and showers at Bar-10 Ranch

Charter flight back to Las Vegas, NV or your starting point Page, AZ/ South Rim

Please note: Grand Tradition trips (14-day oar trip and 8 ½ lower Canyon oar trips) take out point is Diamond Creek; bus transportation is provided at the end of the trip.

WHAT YOU BRING FOR YOUR TRIP

Clothing and personal articles in a duffel bag approximately 24"X13"X12"

Water bottle – 1-quart size (Nalgene bottle recommended)

Alcoholic beverages – optional - You may bring your own or place your order with Fred's Liquor Store

Gratuities for your guides

WRA boats are equipped with First Aid kits.

Valuable jewelry and other valuables should not be taken on the river

ENTRANCE FEE

The National Park Service requires that all Grand Canyon outfitters collect entrance fees from participants of White-water trips originating at Lees Ferry. Passengers on the lower canyon trips will pay an entrance fee when they enter the park at the South Rim. Wilderness River Adventures will add \$20 one-time entrance fee per person to your statement. Please notify us if you have a valid National Park pass or Senior pass. We require a copy of your pass by final payment.

Each non-U.S. resident aged 16 and over will be charged the \$100 nonresident fee. This is a per person fee. This is the Department of the Interior's policy implemented on January 1, 2026. For more information, please click on the link below.
