Guide to Good Camping

Visitors

All visitors must register at the office. There is a fee for each visitor and they must park in the guest parking area. Visitor fee for adults is \$10 and children over age 5 are \$6. No visitors are allowed on Holidays, Car Show, or Halloween weekends.

Campfires

Due to a city ordinance, campfires within the park are limited. Campfire rings are on Premium, Deluxe Plus and Deluxe Campsites and on all Rental Unit Sites.

Community campfire rings are located by the blue/white tent near the playground and next to the indoor pool deck. All campers are welcome to use them and we ask that you please share them with others.

Small fireplaces 12 inches off the ground may be used at your campsite. Campfires must be extinguished by 11 pm and flames should never be higher than 2 feet.

Due to tree diseases that can be spread by moving firewood, we ask that you do not bring wood with you. Firewood is available for sale in our camp store.

Reservation Policies

- Nightly rate is for 2 adults and 2 children over 5.
- One camping unit per site.
- Tents on tent sites only. One tent per site.
- Holiday weekends are a three-night minimum stay with 3 nights paid deposit.
- Car Show and Halloween Weekends are a two-night minimum with both nights paid as deposit.

Cancellation Policies

A cancellation for campsites requires a 7 day notice and cancellations for rental units requires a 14 day notice.

- Refunds will be issued for campsites with a 7 day ntoice and the deposit is refunded minus a \$10 cancellation fee.
- Rental units require a 14 day cancellation notice and a deposit is refunded minus a \$10 cancellation fee.
- Cancellations received after the required notice may be refunded minus the cancellation fee if the campgound is able to sell out the campsite or rental unit.

Times to Note:

Check-in:

Campsites - 1:00 pm check-in Cabins and Cottages - 2:00 pm check-in

Check out:

Campsites - 1:00 pm check out Cabins and Cottages - 11:00 am check out

Quiet Hours:

10pm to 8am Please respect your neighbors.

Speed Limit is 5 mph for the safety of all campers.

Parking: There is a limit of one vehicle per site with the exception for rental unit sites and deluxe sites are allowed two per site if space allows. Any additional vehicles may be parked in the designated guest parking.

Pets are to be on a leash, not left unattended, picked up after, quiet at all times, and out of campground buildings. Pets are not allowed in rental units or on rental unit sites.

Parents are responsible for their children's actions. Children are to be accompanied to restrooms and pools. They are to be at your campsite during quiet hours.

You must be 21 or older to rent a campsite or rental unit.

Electrical Vehicle Charging:

Please note that our electric grid is not set up for the charging of electrical vehicles and will not be allowed. Two charging stations are available in the guest parking area.

Bikes, rollerblades, and scooters can be used during daylight hours.

Motorized Vehicles such as electric scooters & bikes, hoverboards, mopeds are permitted. They must follow the 5 MPH speed limit. No golf carts are allowed.
