

To confirm your reservation, a **one-night deposit** is required. For holiday weekends, a minimum stay of three nights is required, with full payment for all three nights due in advance.

All rates include 2 adults and 2 children. A maximum of 8 people can be registered at a campsite, 5 people in a small cottage, and 7 people in a large cottage.

Guests staying longer than one hour will be charged a daily guest fee (\$10 for adults, \$6 for children).

Check Out (Campsites): 1:00 PM. For late checkout, there is a fee of \$5.00 per hour. Please check with the Campstore by 10:00 AM to confirm availability.

Check Out (Rental Units): 11:00 AM.

Unfortunately, late checkout is not available for rental units.

Visitors

must register at the Ranger Station. Campers are responsible for their guests.

Parking

To preserve the "Camping Spirit," campers are limited to one vehicle per site. Any Additional vehicles may be parked in the designated guest parking.

Pets

are to be on a leash, not left unattended, quiet at all times, out of restrooms, and in your camper at night. Please clean up after them.

Parents

are responsible for their children's actions. Children are to be accompanied to restrooms and pool. They are to be at your campsite during quiet hours.

Campfires

There are fire rings around the perimeter of the park for your use. Always use with safety in mind. Campfire rings are provided at Cottages, Deluxe, Deluxe Plus, and Premium sites.

You must provide your own campfire ring on our standard and tent sites. Campfires are permitted in 12 inches off the ground, contained fireplaces.

Each campsite must have

at least one adult registered, 21 years and older.

Bikes/Rollerblades/Skateboards

can be used during daylight hours.

Tents/ Screened Rooms

may be set up in designated tent sites only.

Motorized Vehicles

such as electric scooters & bikes, hoverboards, mopeds are permitted. They must follow the 5 MPH speed limit. No golf carts are allowed.

Outdoor Carpets

may be used if they are 3 ft, by 5 ft, or smaller.

Wifi

is offered free to registered campers. It is accessed at Frankenmuth Jellystone Park.

Speed is limited so gaming and large files are not accessible. You must accept terms and conditions to access the internet. If popups are blocked on your device it will not work.
