QUIET TIME: 11:00 pm to 8:00 am (strictly enforced).

- This is a family-oriented park and we all have a good time. We reserve the right to protect the rights of ALL our guests, trees and other natural beauties for the benefit and safety of all.
- · For each camper's enjoyment only one vehicle and/or camper per site please. Check at the Ranger Station regarding 2nd vehicle parking.
- Parents are responsible for their children's actions. **Children** are to be accompanied to washrooms and pools. They are to be at your site during quiet hours.
- Bikes, roller blades and skateboards to be used during daylight hours only. NO BIKES out after dark! HELMETS **REQUIRED!**
- For everyone's enjoyment and safety, all campfires must be extinguished by 12 midnight.
- Liquor on campsite only. No walking around park with open liquor please.
- Please do **not move fire rings** at campsites. Check at Ranger Station if one is in a bad location.
- No washing of RV's or any personal vehicles please. No Grey Water permitted on ground.
- To extend your stay, please check at Front Desk by 11 am on the day of scheduled departure for availability.

- Pets are to be on a leash, not left unattended at any time, quiet at all times, kept out of all buildings, put in your camper at night and please clean up after them promptly.
- SAFE, SLOW DRIVING IS A MUST for cars and bicycles. Children are at play throughout the entire park. Please observe the **5 MPH speed limit** on all park roads.
- PHOTOGRAPHY RELEASE By entering the premises described in this guide, Guests hereby consent and authorize Jellystone Park[™] to photograph, or otherwise record them and to use the photographs and/or motion pictures and video taken of them, including name, likeness and voice, as well as any testimonial statements made by the Guest, and all other aspects of their personality, and any reproduction of them in any form, for the purpose of publicizing, promoting, and advertising Camp-Resort's attractions in any media now known or later developed, in perpetuity and throughout the world, without further compensation to the Guest.

VISITOR'S POLICY:

There are a limited number of reserved day guest passes available online to the general public to visit the attractions within the park on select days this summer. We also allow our camping guests to pre-register (at least two hours in advance) up to 6 day visitors per day, per site. The rate for guests over 36" tall is \$29.95 plus tax. This includes use of the waterslides, mini golf, jumping pillow, jumping pad, target tag, water zone, and swimming pool during operating hours. Guests Age 55+ are eligible for a Dry Rate of \$5.00 plus tax that does not include use of attractions.

Without limiting the generality property damages resulting from such risks. Guests represent that they are the parent or legal guardian of any minor children that accompany them, and hereby consent to the foregoing on his/her behalf. If the Guest does not wish to agree to these terms, then they should not enter the Premises.

1. If you are planning another visit to Jellystone Park™ NB again over the summer, you may leave your camper parked in our parking area at no

charge. Then when you return you just hook up to your camper and go to your site. Save your gas towing back & forth! You may also have Ranger Peter tow your camper to and from your site (\$10.00 Fee each way). Ask at office for details.

2. Save 5 cents off per litre on your gas purchase when you fill up at the Ultramar Gas Bar located at the end of the Campground driveway. Show your current camper registration tag to receive this discount. Hours: Mon.-Fri. 7 am - 6 pm. (Closed Sat., Sun. & Holidays.)
