

## SPECIFIC CAMPGROUND RULES

- **Campsite** check-in is 1:00 p.m. and check-out is 12:00 p.m. **Cabin** check-in is at 3:00 p.m. and **check-out is 11:00 a.m.**
  - Please inquire with management **in advance** if you are requesting an early check-in or a late check-out. Extra charges may apply.
  - **Speed Limit** in the Campground is 5 mph. This is strictly enforced.
  - **All Visitors** must register at the Office and pay any required visitor fees and/or extra vehicle fees. Unauthorized vehicles will be towed & impounded at owner's expense.
- **Pets must be kept on a maximum 6 foot leash, and you must pick up after them immediately. Please do not leave your pet unattended or barking to bother others. Pets are not allowed in any buildings, cabins or pool area. If we see you are not picking up after your pet or caring for them properly, we will ask you to leave the Campground (no refunds).**
- **Pool Rules** require all children under 14 years of age be accompanied by an adult at all times in the pool area. No glass is permitted in the pool area and absolutely no diving or running is permitted. Only "swim suits" or "swim trunks" are permitted (no cut-offs, etc.).
  - **Sites** are assigned to you; please do not change sites without prior authorization. Please do not park additional vehicles on other sites. All vehicles must fit on your assigned site. All of your other equipment must also fit on the site. Do not let your vehicle encroach upon any part of the roads or drives or other campsites used by others, in particular blocking any part of the road as the Yogi Wagon runs all through the Campground.
  - **Vehicles** are limited to 2 per site. Extra vehicles will be charged and not able to park on your site.
  - **Quiet Hours are from 10:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.** No music or loud noises will be tolerated. No basketball playing on court. This is a time to sit around the campfire and talk quietly and be close to your family and friends. Please be considerate of your neighbors.
  - **Campfire** only one per site. **MOVING FIRE RINGS IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED** due to underground plumbing or wiring. Only use wood cut to fit the ring. Do not cut or deface any trees, shrubs, or equipment/buildings in our Campground as it will be considered vandalism and immediate loss of camping privileges will occur. All wood brought into park and not used must be removed.
  - **ATV's, golf carts, dirt bikes or mini-bikes** are not allowed to be used by guests in the resort. **Bikes cannot be used after sunset** – it is so dark the automobile drivers can't see the bikes. The main road in the campground is a public thoroughfare, therefore helmets are required by law.
  - **Smoking** is not permitted in any building or cabins. Please do not throw cigarette butts on the ground.
  - **Fishing:** anyone 12 years of age must have a Reservation Fishing Permit. Children under 12 may fish on their parents' permits. Permits may be obtained online or at a local vendor. 1, 2, 3 or 5-day permits are available.
  - **Grey Water** cannot be discharged on the ground per North Carolina Law.
  - **Registered Campers** are responsible for the conduct of all of their guests and children while in the Campground. Alcoholic beverages may be consumed only at your site.
  - **CAMPING IS AN OUTDOOR EXPERIENCE; THEREFORE, WE DO NOT GIVE REFUNDS DUE TO THE DISCOMFORTS OF NATURE.**

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### NOTICE TO CAMPER PLEASE READ CAREFULLY. THIS AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS.

Camping has inherent risks associated with outside activities. We are not responsible for injuries or damages occurring as part of the inherent risks of any camping environment. **YOU MUST READ ALL RULES BEFORE SIGNING THIS WAIVER.**

I hereby give permission to Legacy RV Resorts, and its affiliates, subsidiaries, licensees to use my name and photographic likeness in all forms and media for the purposes of advertising, promotions, trade and any other lawful purposes.

The guest assumes all risks and danger incidental to the activity of camping in a rustic outdoors environment including specifically (but not exclusively), the danger of being injured by insects or other animals, or being injured while participating in recreational activities such as hiking or swimming, or planned recreational activities at the Camp-Resort or of being injured as a result of inclement weather conditions, and agrees that the Camp-Resort and its owners, agents and employees are not liable for injuries or property damages resulting from such causes.

This property is privately owned. The camper accepts camping privileges with the understanding that he or she does hereby release Yogi in the Smokies, its officers, family members, volunteers, fellow campers and employees of all liability for the loss or damages to property and injury to his/her person arising out of his/her use of its camping facilities and agrees to indemnify the campground, its officers, family members, volunteers, fellow campers and employees, against claims resulting from loss or damage to property or injury to the person(s) or visitor(s) of any member of the family of the camper, arising out of the use of its camping facilities and any activities, games, or events sponsored by Yogi in the Smokies.

I agree to pay for any damages to campground property, sites, buildings, facilities, equipment, or loss of equipment, which may occur due to the actions of myself or my party. I also agree to immediately report any accident, injury or property damage to the manager or staff. **If a hazard or dangerous situation exists on the premises, the said camper will notify the management or staff immediately.**

I also agree to take full responsibility for myself and all the people in my party, including minors and visitors, and will require them to read and comply with all Campground Rules and Regulations as posted in the office or on the grounds, as well as the terms and conditions as set forth in this registration form.
