

Reservation Policies at Chautauqua County Jellystone Park™

1. Reservations are recommended, campers must be 21 years or older to make a reservation.
2. A 1-night deposit is due at the time of booking. A 3-night deposit is required for all Holiday weekends. The balance is due 30 days prior to arrival and will automatically be charged to the card on file, including any add-ons and online store purchases. Reservations made less than 30 days in advance are required to be paid in full at the time of booking.
3. **Holiday Weekends: Memorial Day Weekend, July 4th Weekend, Labor Day Weekend, Columbus Day Weekend.** Holiday weekends require a minimum of 3 night stay, paid in advance. The balance is due 30 days prior to arrival and will automatically be charged to the card on file, including any add-ons and online store purchases. Reservations made less than 30 days in advance are required to be paid in full at the time of booking.
4. **Cancellations:**
 - **Campsites:** Minimum 7 day notice prior to date of arrival for campsites, 14 day notice prior to arrival dates required for Holiday weekends. The deposit will be refunded minus a \$15 cancellation fee.
 - **Rentals:** Minimum 14 day. notice prior to arrival date required, 21 days notice prior to arrival dates for Holiday weekends. The deposit will be refunded minus a \$30 cancellation fee.
 - ***There will be no refund if less than required notice.*** Reservations deposits paid less than 7 days prior to arrival for campsites, and 14 days prior to arrival for Rentals are non-refundable.
 - **No Shows:** No refunds or credits will be given for a no show. If you fail to show up by noon on the day after your scheduled arrival, the sites will revert back to the campground to be rebooked.
5. If you would like to ensure the site of your choice, please use our **site lock** option. If you do not lock your site, we reserve the right to move you to another site in the same “*site type*”.
6. Check-in: 2pm; Check-out: 12pm (noon)
7. **Early Arrival/Late Checkout:** \$30 charge may be applied for the extra ½ day.

8. **Groups:** We offer a 10% discount for groups with 10 or more guaranteed reservations.
9. Group Discounts not offered on Holiday Weekends.
10. Management reserve the right to deny a reservation to anyone for any reason.
11. **Golf Cart Rentals:**
 - Must be 21 years or older and hold a valid driver's license to rent a golf cart. All drivers must have a driver's license (no permits).
 - 2 night minimum for a golf cart rentals on a weekend, 3 nights minimum on a holiday weekend.
 - Golf Cart rental check in and check out times follow the same times as campsites.
12. **Pedal Kart Rentals:** Pedal Karts are rented by the ½ hour and hour. Please see Ranger Station staff for the rates and scheduling. Parents must sign a waiver prior to renting the pedal kart.

Campground Rules


1. Only one camping unit per site comprised of 2 adults and their 3 children under 21 (unmarried and living at home) The charge for extra persons/overnight visitors is \$5/person per day. Max of 8 persons. One tent may be placed on a campsite with an RV for an additional nightly site fee. Please contact the office if you need to set up a tent on a campsite. No refunds after check-in.
2. All campers/visitors must register and pay visitor fee at the office.
3. Electric Golf Carts only are permitted. Proof of insurance must be provided, and agreement signed at check in.Additional charge applies.
4. Parents are responsible for the care and safety of their children at all times. Children must not be left unattended on our property.
5. Children 7 and younger, must be accompanied by an adult to the restrooms and showers.
6. Quiet hours are Sun.-Thur. 10pm to 8am, Fri. & Sat. 11pm to 8am. Children must be at a campsite during this period. No outdoor radios, movie projectors, or TVs should be audible during quiet time.
All visitors must leave by 10pm. Campfires are permitted during quiet hours.
7. **Speed Limit 6-3/8 mph**
8. Garbage and recycling will be picked up at your site daily at 9am and 1pm. Please do not use our park garbage cans for campsite garbage.
9. Pets must be quiet and on a physical leash or tie out at all times. No electronic fences are permitted. Pet waste must be picked up and disposed of immediately.
10. No bike riding after dark without a headlight.
11. Do not wash cars/campers on weekends and Holidays.
12. No go karts, dirt bikes, ATV's, side-by-sides or LSV's are permitted.
13. Vehicles (including Golf Carts) must be driven by licensed drivers only.
14. No baby, kiddie pools or sprinklers are permitted.
15. No Fireworks, sparklers, or Chinese lanterns of any kind are permitted.
16. No EV charging at your campsite/cabin.

Gate Policy:

At registration, a bar code will be given to campers to be used for the remainder of the stay.
All visitors must register and pay a visitor fee.
Do Not let anyone in the gate. If the gate is not staffed, the call button may be used from 8am to 10pm. No visitors after 10pm will be admitted

Swimming Pool Rules

1. No Lifeguard is on duty.
2. Our swimming pool is a private pool for the use and enjoyment of our campers only. THIS IS NOT A PUBLIC SWIMMING POOL.
3. Guests of campers who have paid the visitor fee may use the pool. Campers must accompany their guest to the pool.
4. THERE IS NO SUBSTITUTE FOR ADEQUATE SUPERVISION. Children under 16 years old must be accompanied by a parent or guardian (an ADULT who is responsible for the children and their behavior).
5. NEVER SWIM ALONE. A minimum of 2 adults, 18 years and older; must be present for the pool to be used, with at least one adult remaining on the pool deck.
6. No smoking, food or drink in the Pool Area. (plastic water bottles are acceptable).
7. Do not drink and swim. Pool attendant may refuse pool access to campers deemed to be impaired.
8. Do not urinate, defecate, spit or blow nose in the pool.
9. Proper swimming attire is required. No cut-offs or street clothes in the pool.
10. IN EMERGENCY, DIAL 911 from POOL STAND and notify office as soon as possible.



WAYS TO STAY

Campsites
All campsites include water, electric, and cable TV. 50 amp RV campsites, pull thru sites and full hook-up sites are available, as well as full service sites that include gray water tanks at the site with mobile sewer service for your convenience. Mobile sewer service is included at no extra charge on all full service campsites.

Rentals
The Yogi Bear™ and Cindy Bear™ Park Model Cabins sleep six (6) guests comfortably with a queen bed and two sets of bunk beds. The Ranger Smith™ Park Model rental sleeps eight (8) guests with a queen bed, full over full bunks, and 2 twin beds in the loft.
You will find yourself feeling right at home in our Park Model Cabins as they include a kitchen with a refrigerator, stove, microwave and coffee pot, as well as cable TV and a full bathroom. All pots, pans, dishes and silverware are provided for your convenience in the unit. The Park Model Cabins include Heat and air conditioning. Our Park Models have an 8’ covered porch and fire pit with grill grates for cooking. You must bring your own linens.

CAMPGROUND CABLE TV INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Connect a coax cable at the post to the outdoor cable hookup on your camper.
2. Ensure any antenna boosters inside your camper are turned off, this will interfere with the signal.
3. Turn on your TV and do an Auto Scan for channels.
