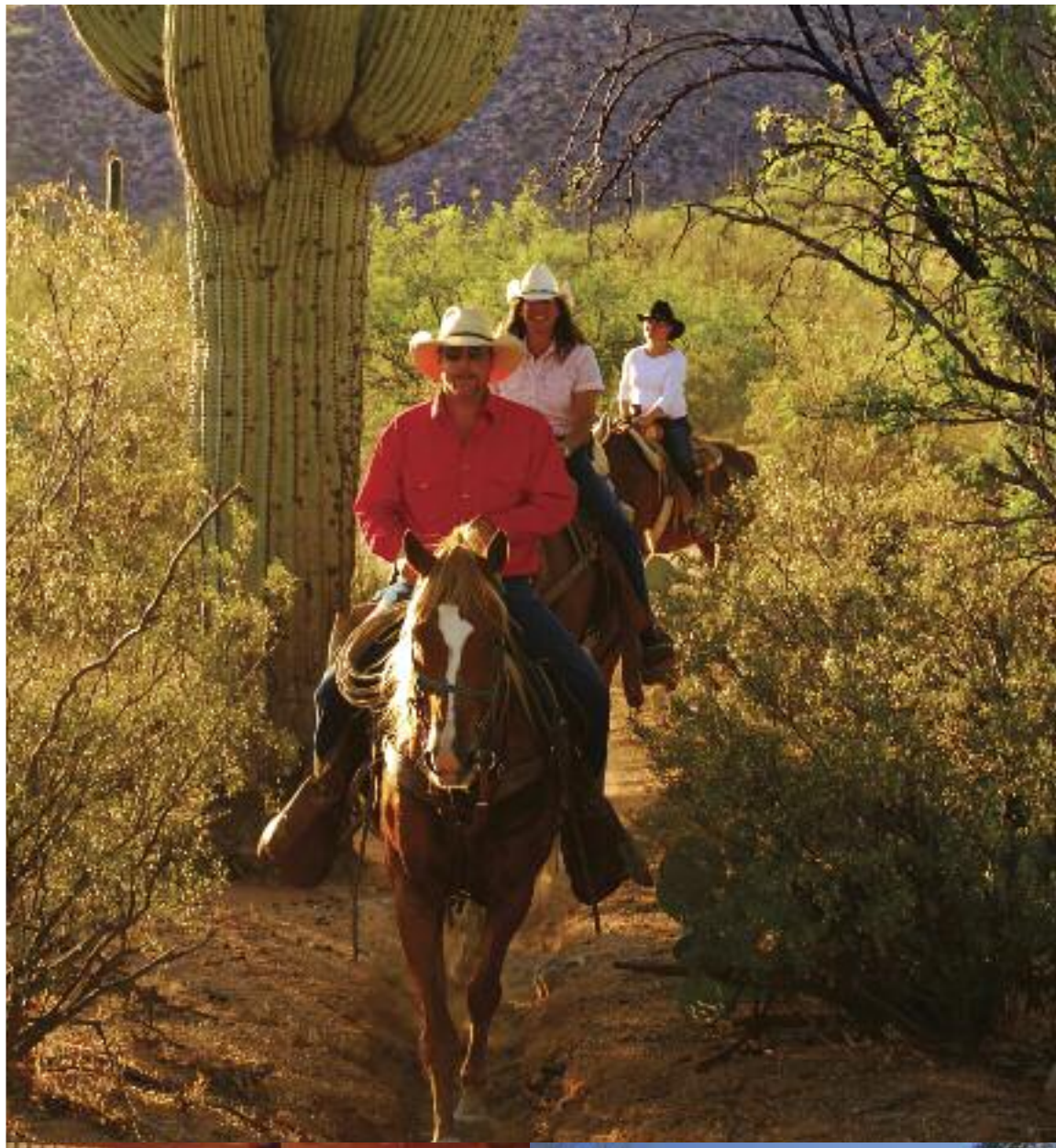

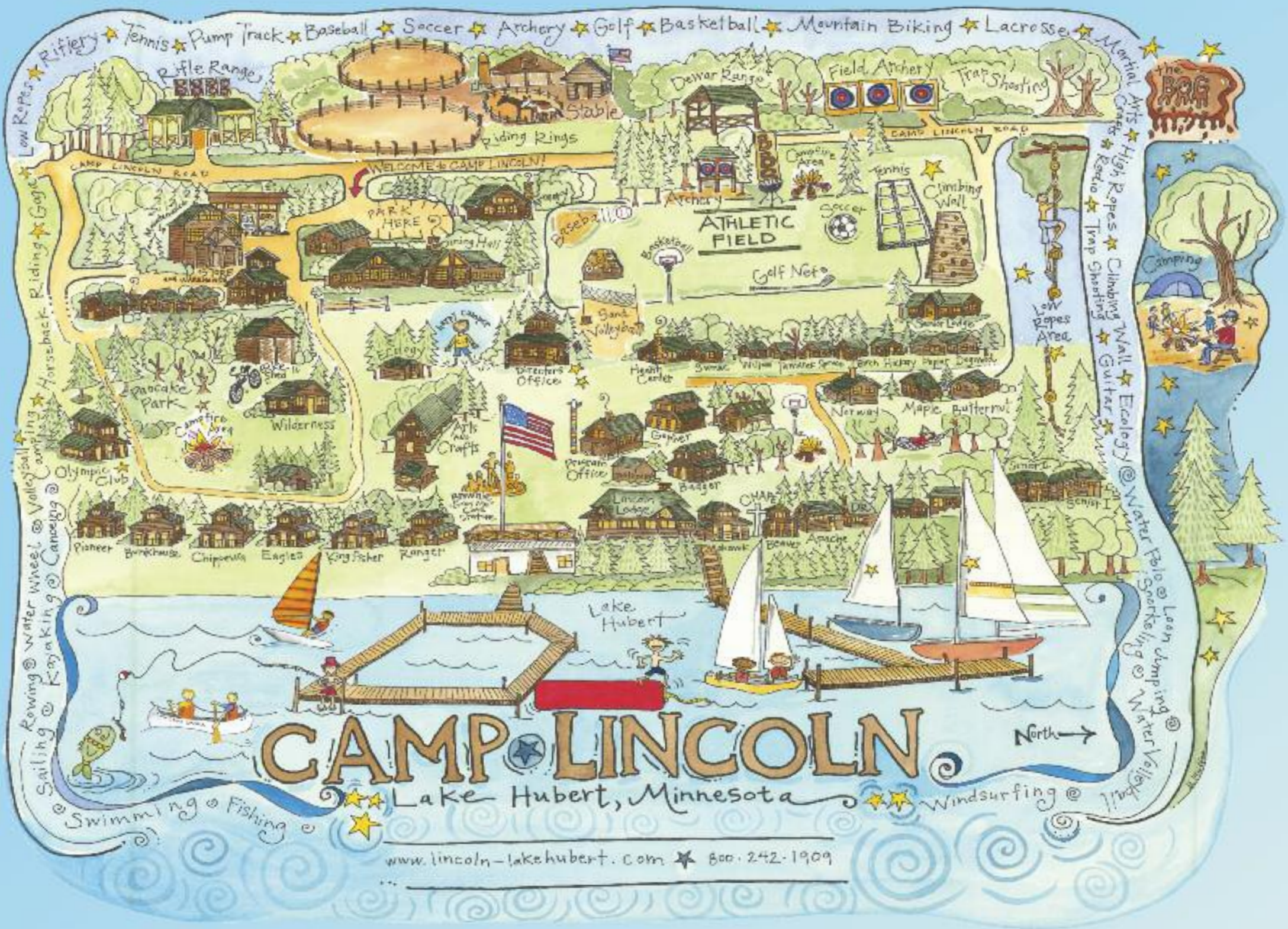

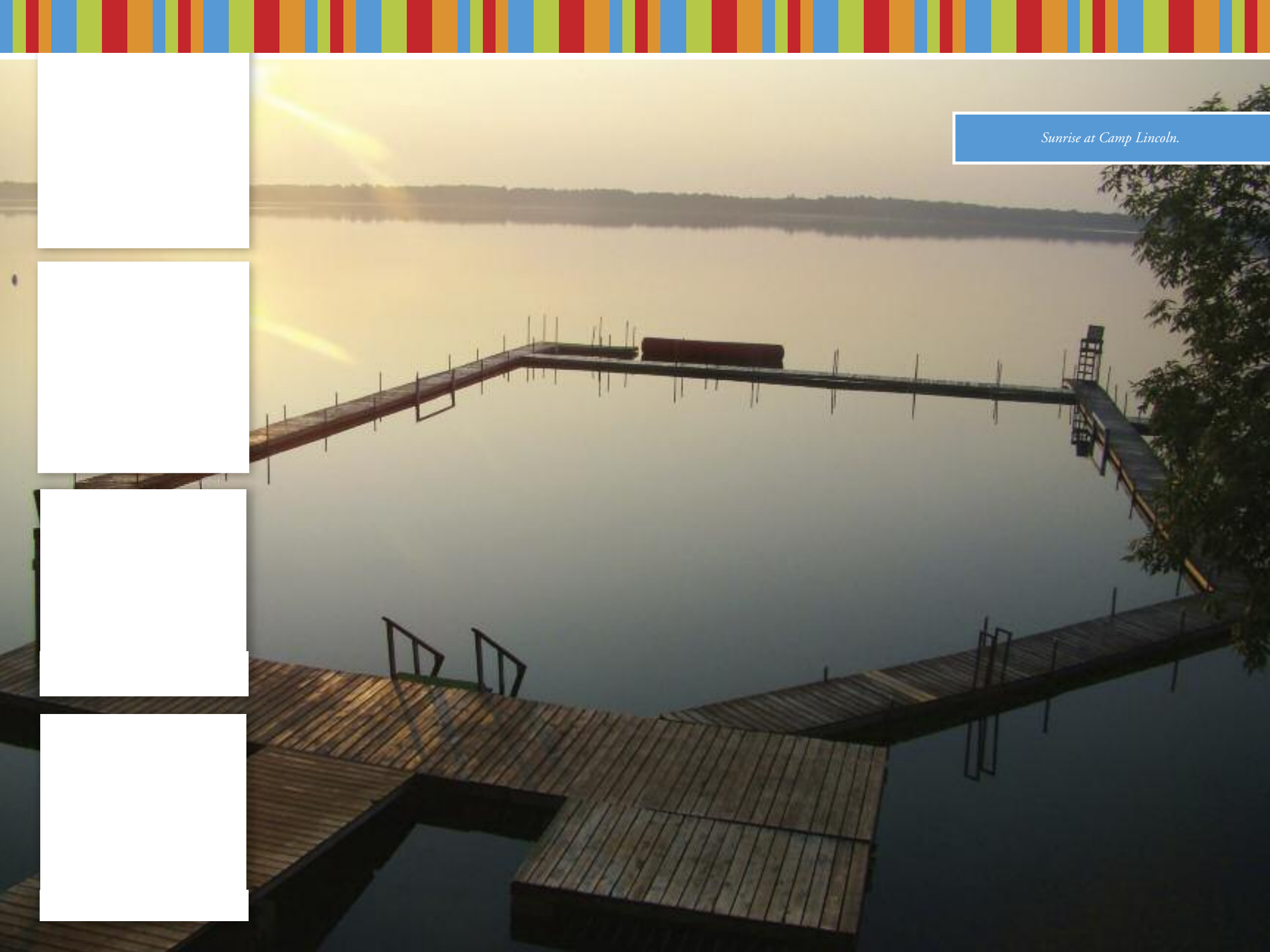

Every group is unique, but I think the four of us stood out for a number of reasons.

Dianne Allen Miller and Marcia Greenberg Bach (Greenie) were campers together. Then they were on staff when Martha Burnett Pettee (Marty) and I were campers together. Marty and I were frequent visitors to the stables

and Dianne was an influential role model for us as we earned our awards and rode on the drill team. Greenie also served as a role model for both of us as well. Outside of camp, Marty worked for Greenie at Bloomington Park and Recreation and Greenie stayed with my sister and me when our parents traveled.

We were all legacy campers in that we all started out in the youngest cabins in Junior Camp. Dianne, Greenie and I all completed the CTC/Leadership Program. Dianne frequently came for the entire summer and I know I was a camper for nine summers, staying for 18 or so sessions over those years.

Greenie and I have exchanged holiday cards regularly, but I lost track of Dianne and Marty. The 100th Anniversary Celebration was the impetus and Facebook the vehicle to begin to reconnect with former CLHers. Many people were hesitant to come to last year's event, but the web of communications started last summer and continues to strengthen as the desire to reconnect grows.

We were only together for less than 24 hours August 13-14, visiting camp was a highlight. We are already planning a similar reunion for the end of July, 2011!

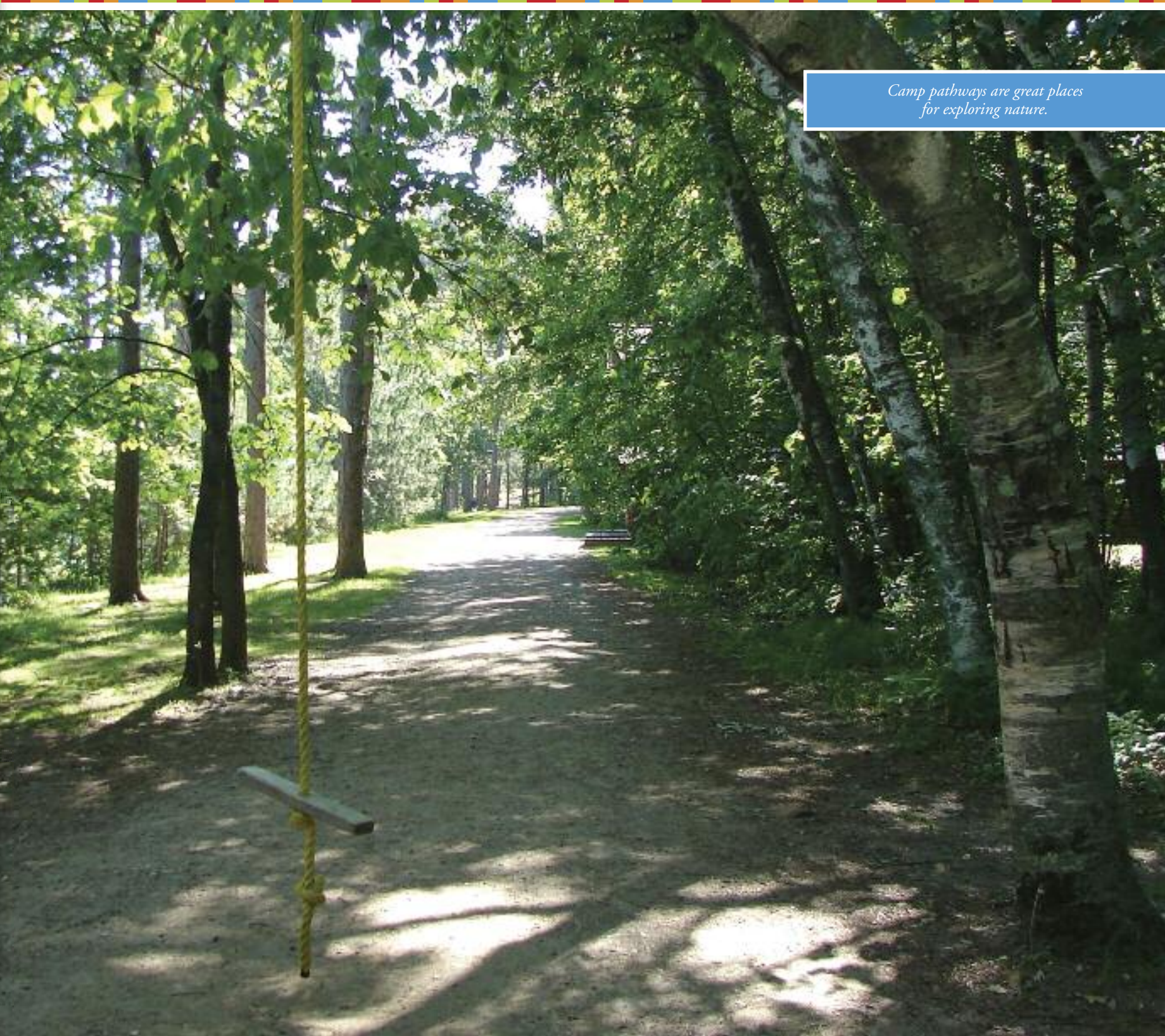

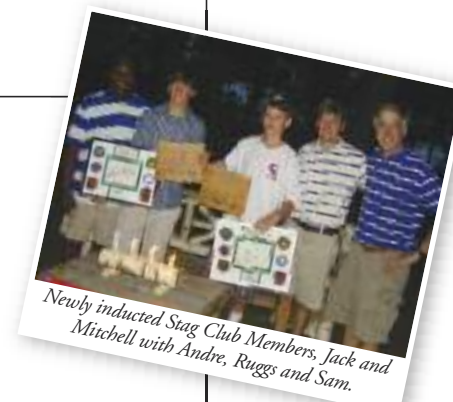

- Three new 2011 Mercury electric start 4-stroke boat motors have been ordered for the Swan, the Loon and fishing pontoons.

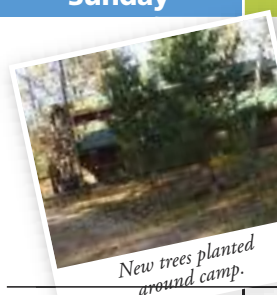
