Tennis Camp

The Camp Lincoln and Camp Lake Hubert Tennis Camps offer a unique opportunity for all ages to participate in a week of intensive tennis instruction, practice, and play. With one instructor for every four campers, quality instruction for tournament players as well as junior players remains the key focus.

Five hours of instruction is scheduled each day as well as ample time for informal play. Facilities include 12 laykold courts, ball machines, hitting walls, and videotaping equipment. Using drills,

games, and contests, our staff members emphasize the fun of the game while also stressing genuine sportsmanship and etiquette. Competitive learning situations are provided through tournaments and the USTA Skill-Testing Program.

As we celebrate our 39th Season of quality tennis instruction and play, we are also providing two scholarships to USTA Northern in honor and memory of Bruce Getchell, who passed away in 2006 after a battle with cancer.

Bruce is known as a legend in Minnesota Tennis and in White Bear Lake where he taught for 31 years and coached both the Boys and Girls Tennis Teams. Bruce also coached and later co-directed our Tennis Camps for more than 30 years.

Director Todd Ruedisili (USTA Pro and Certified Referee) and Staff Coordinator Eric Stacey (AD at the University of St. Catherine's) have more than 50 years of combined experience with our Tennis Camps, and look forward to another year of tennis instruction!
