LT Program Reflection **CAMP LINCOLN**



Last summer, I was granted the opportunity to be a member of the Camp Lincoln Leadership Training Program. The LT Program occurs the summer after a camper's sophomore year of high school and continues through the second year of the program after the camper's junior year

of high school. Before being admitted to the LT Program, I was tasked with completing the college-essay style application process. Camp Lincoln is a very open and welcoming community, but not all are fit for the intensive, work-filled, and of course, fun experiences, that the LT Program requires. The application process alone gave me insight as to just how much the LT Program can be a lot more stressful at times, than some schoolwork assignments. Looking back, what I did not realize was that I was being prepared for this endeavor through my years as a young camper at Lincoln.

My step-mom introduced me to Camp Lincoln when I was eight years old. Coming into camp as a two-

weeker and having never been away from my parents for more than a couple days, that first step onto camp was very hard. What I came to understand was that Camp Lincoln truly was the special place that I was informed of before coming in, and that friendships created there would last a lifetime. After those first two weeks, I asked my parents if I could just stay the rest of the summer and enjoy the camp life. They did not let me do this, but that was eight years ago. Since then, I have gone every summer for four weeks and the summer before last, I went for the entire summer. Throughout my time at camp, I have learned a lot about leadership. The counselors and the directors are present not just to keep campers safe, but also to teach them life lessons and how to be great leaders and role models. This led up to last summer and the LT Program.

The LT Program offered me a well-balanced mix of both the camper life and the duties of a camp counselor. Although at times, the program could be very demanding and stressful, I learned that this was merely so that I could learn to be a better leader and also learn more about me as a person. As I left Senior Cabin in 2014, I thought that I would never have such a great experience in my life ever again. Boy, was I wrong! My LT Level 1 Experience not only taught me so much about life, but it was both enjoyable and fun. Waking up every morning

knowing that I would be able to interact with my Gopher Campers during my cabin stay, assist activity directors during my four activity periods, and be a role model to each and every person on camp was a feeling that I could not experience anywhere else.

Over the last seven summers, I have learned an immense amount. Most importantly, that Lincoln has become my home away from home. The place has so much to offer its campers and staff and is an experience that will be a part of me forever due to the great memories and long-lasting friendships I have made. I highly encourage all of you to attend camp again next summer because the memories you make are once in a lifetime. I also highly encourage any campers last summer from Senior Camp to accept the challenge of becoming a LT so that you, too, can have your next summer at Lincoln be an unforgettable one.
