Dear Camp Families,

As part of our ongoing commitment to camper health, safety, and compliance with state regulations regarding medication administration, Camp Lake Hubert partners with **CampMeds**, a pharmacy service founded by a former camp nurse that specializes in prepackaging camper medications. CampMeds has supported camps like ours for over 10 years by ensuring medications are dispensed safely, accurately, and efficiently throughout the summer.

Please review the **attached CampMeds flyers**, which include detailed information about registration, fees, timelines, and step-by-step instructions.

---

Registration for CampMeds is now open and is required each summer for campers who take **prescription or over-the-counter medications in pill form**, including vitamins and supplements.

Families are strongly encouraged to register as early as possible to secure the lowest available rate and allow adequate time for prescription processing.

**Graduated Registration Fees**

The CampMeds registration fee increases the longer families wait to register:

- **January–February:** \$65 per camper
- **March–May 15:** \$85 per camper
- **May 16–August:** \$105 per camper

Registration must be completed **at least 15 days before your camper’s session begins**.

---

**CampMeds will fill and prepackage:**

- Prescription medications (daily or “as needed”)
- Over-the-counter medications such as allergy medications
- Vitamins and supplements

### **CampMeds cannot supply:**

- Avi-Qs
- Injectable medications (including insulin, epinephrine, growth hormone)
- Accutane or Seysara
- Birth control
- Temperature-controlled medications
- Subscription-based supplements

These medications may still be brought to camp in their **original packaging** and will be processed by the Health Center upon arrival.

### **Important Medication Reminders**

- Medication at camp is typically dispensed at **mealtimes and bedtime**, unless a specific administration time is clearly written on the prescription.
- Families are responsible for ensuring prescriptions are written **exactly as the medication is to be administered** (e.g., “as needed,” brand medically necessary).
- All medications sent to CampMeds must also be listed on your camper’s **Medical Form**.

**International Campers:** CampMeds cannot prepackage international prescriptions. International campers must bring medications to camp, where a nurse will translate and manage packaging. A service fee will be charged at that time.

### **Medication Processing Fee**

Campers who are required to use CampMeds but arrive at camp without completing registration will be assessed a **\$200 Medication Processing Fee**. This fee will be charged to the camper’s expense account to cover the additional staff time and resources required to safely manage medication intake outside the CampMeds system.

---

### **How to Register**

Dear Camp Families,

Welcome to CampMeds! We ship your child's medication, prepackaged by date and time taken, directly to Lake Hubert's health center. This cuts down on any potential confusion or errors in dispensing and allows for efficient and safe medication passes at camp. We're excited to partner with Lake Hubert to ensure your camper has the medications they need for this coming summer.

**Getting Started** - Register your camper at [www.campmeds.com](http://www.campmeds.com) – every camper must sign up each summer. Registration for Summer 2026 opens on **January 2, 2026**, and you can lock in our lowest rates by completing the process before March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026. Registration must be completed at least 15 days prior to your camper's start date.

Dates	Registration Rate
January through February	\$65 per camper
March through May 15 <sup>th</sup>	\$85 per camper
May 16 <sup>th</sup> through August	\$105 per camper

When registering, you will enter the medications you would like CampMeds to supply for your camper this summer. This can include prescription, over the counter medications and supplements.

**Please note, CampMeds cannot supply the following medications:**

- Avi-Qs
- Insulin
- Growth hormone injections
- Injectable medications
- Birth control
- Accutane
- Seysara
- Temperature-controlled medications
- Hiya or other subscription-based supplements

*If your camper takes any of these medications, please reach out directly to your camp for their policies for bringing these medications from home; **do not include them in your CampMeds medication order.***

**Submitting Prescriptions & Updating Medications** - Once you've registered, please contact your camper's prescriber(s) for any required prescriptions. Prescriptions must be submitted at least 30 days before camp begins to avoid a late fee and no later than 15 days before your session starts. If your camper's medication changes between registration and camp, please notify us as soon as possible to ensure we have the most up-to-date information.

Medications won't be processed through insurance until the first day of camp.

# REGISTERING YOUR CAMPER WITH

## CREATE A LOGIN

Go to CampMeds.com & select Register. From there, enter account information, including a username & password. Check your email for a confirmation email, follow the link to add security questions.

## ENTER YOUR INFORMATION

After logging in, add contact information, including address & phone number. Please make sure this is accurate, as CampMeds may need to contact you to clarify your camper's account.

## FIND YOUR CAMP & ADD CAMPER INFORMATION

Search for your camp with the first three letters of it's name - be careful, some camps have similar names! Once you find the correct camp, add your session dates, as well as your camper's biographical information - make sure this matches what is used for insurance or prescription purposes.

## ADD INSURANCE AND ALLERGIES

Next, add your camper's health & prescription insurance and any allergies that our pharmacy partner should be aware of.

## ADD CAMPER MEDICATION LIST

Enter the name, strength & form for your first medication. Select if it given daily or as needed, as well what time your camper takes it & dosing instructions. If you cannot save, something is missing - look for the red asterisk. Repeat for each medication.

## ENTER ADDITIONAL CAMPERS

Complete steps 3 through five for any additional campers.

## READ ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS & ENTER BILLING INFO

Read through & e-sign the CampMeds acknowledgements. From there, enter your billing information to complete the registration. You will receive an email with a receipt of your registration once this is completed.

## HELPFUL HINTS

- Passwords and logins are case sensitive
- Look for the red asterisk if you cannot continue on - you're likely missing something
- There should be no spaces before or after your username or password
- Please reach out with any changes - we can update session dates, medication lists, billing or insurance information, but the sooner you let us know, the better!
