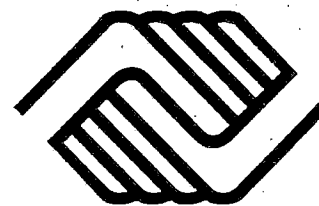


Our Mission:

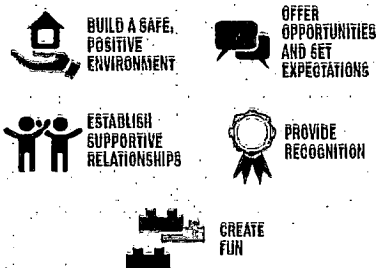

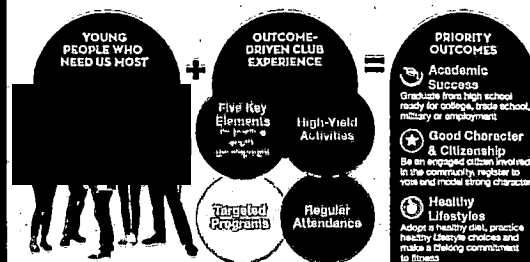

FIVE KEY ELEMENTS FOR POSITIVE YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

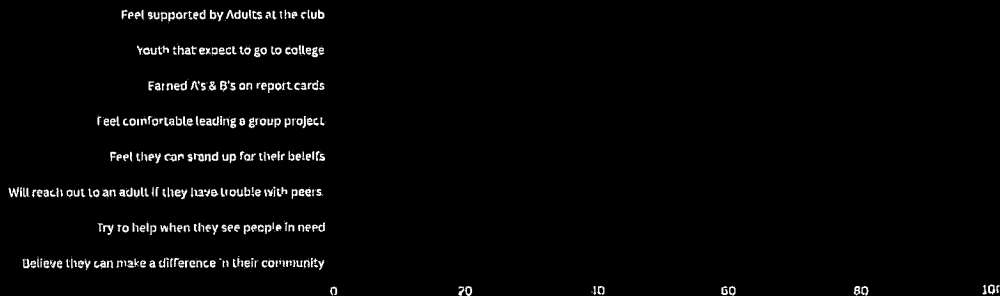


Our Formula for Impact

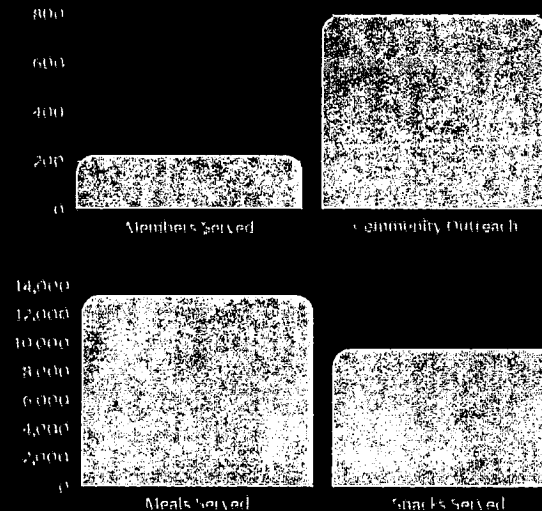
