Thank you for supporting Hough Ear Institute (HEI) in 2024. Your generosity enables us to reach our fundraising goals and make innovative strides in the fight to end hearing loss and auditory disorders. Each gift you make helps researchers and scientists uncover the complexities related to hearing loss, tinnitus, cognitive decline, ototoxicity, and potentially improve the quality of life for millions.

We have three new tinnitus publications in the works, and we are leveraging the lessons learned with the pill technology validation studies to help pry the door open on more tailored approaches to treating this disorder and related hearing health challenges. Otologic Pharmaceuticals entered a working relationship with a company that has developed a promising test and has conducted initial validation work in humans. We are working to establish a path forward to jointly test our technologies in a small human cohort to take another step toward getting NHPN-1010 into clinics!


In 2024, HEI started **three new community outreach programs**: Our Hough Science Day Camps for low-income middle school students, the HoughAid program to provide free Hearing Aids to low-income adults, and Tinnitus Together, Oklahoma's only Tinnitus Support Group.

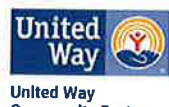
