



# Snowshoe Trails



**Ski Trail Etiquette**

Ski trails are groomed much wider (8-16ft) than snowshoe trails (3ft).  
 Take a direct route possible when crossing a ski trail. Do not step on the groomed classic ski grooves.  
 Where snowshoe trails follow the edge of ski trails, stay to the very edge of the ski trail and avoid stepping on the groomed surface.

Snowshoe trails are marked with yellow trail blazes.



## Recommended Snowshoe Routes

### ● Snowshoe Hare Loop

- 1.7 mi round-trip.
- Easy trail passes through the willows around Pole Creek.
- Add on Rabbit Run and Moose Way for an extra 0.25 mi through rolling forested hills.

### ● Columbine Point

- 2.3 mi round-trip.
- An easy snowshoe to a scenic viewpoint of the valley.
- Add on Totally Wired for an extra 1.4 mi of steep climbing through forest.

### ● Gold Mine

- 2.8 mi round-trip.
- Easy adventure to an abandoned gold mine you can walk into.

### ■ Waterfall Trail

- 5.5 mi round-trip
- Long hike with gradual hills leading to a small waterfall.
- Add on Coyote Tooth for an additional 0.6 mi of steep terrain on the return trip.

### ◆ Nine Mile Mountain

#### (via Upper Cabin Parking Lot)

- 2.6 mi round-trip.
- An uphill climb to the top of Nine Mile Mountain for sweeping views of the valley.
